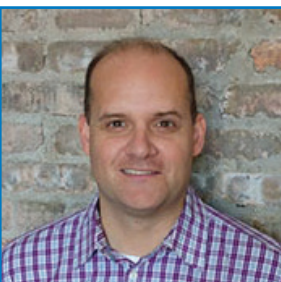
Karl Cassell
